Free Exploration or Teacher Led Activities

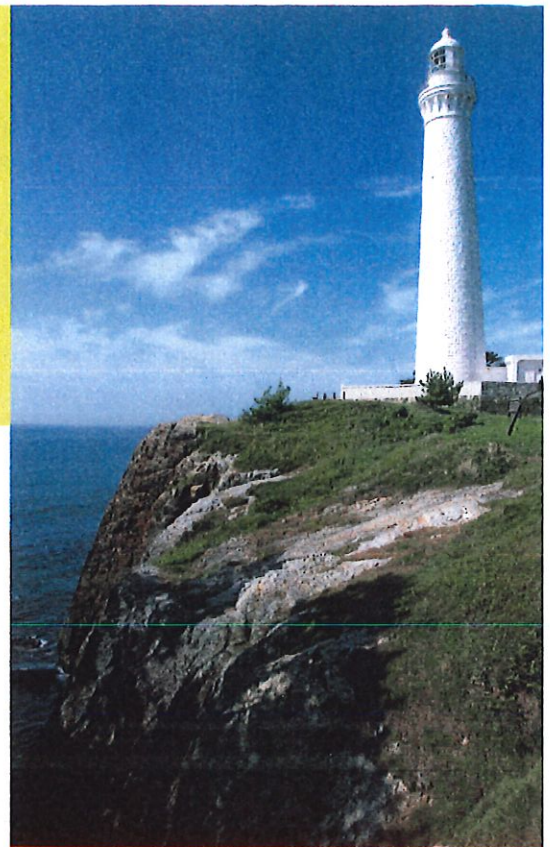
