Called to Fight

Ephesians 6:10-13

"10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm."

As we begin our deep dive into Ephesians this summer, we come across one of the most famous passages in the New Testament. The armor of God. Yet, despite being a famous passage it is one we need to be constantly reminded of, especially as we live in a world that is becoming more openly hostile to God's Word. So, let us dive in!

First, notice that we are fighting. The life of a Christian is one that is a constant battle. In fact, when Luther talks about baptism he makes the point that when a person is being baptized, they are putting a bullseye on their back for the devil. The devil knows now that the baptized person is his enemy and will do everything in his power to make sure that person comes over to his side. What this means for us then is that we should expect our lives not to be easy. For the devil wants you and your soul and will not stop trying to get it. That is the reality, and this battle does not end until God calls us to be with him or until he returns.

Yet, that does not mean when should be scared or feel hopeless amid this fight. For our God does not leave us helpless but has given us the equipment necessary to go into the battle. He gives us the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, the gospel of peace for shoes, the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirt. He equips us with everything we need to fight the devil and all that he assails us with. However, notice all of this is found in God and what he has done for us. So, in amidst the battles that each one of you are going through lean on Christ and what he has given to you, namely his Word and Sacraments. If we try to lean on our own power to withstand the assaults of the devil, we will most certainly fail. Yet, with the power and help of Christ we with stand firm against everything. So, lean on Christ during your trials!

The second thing Paul reminds us of is who we are fighting in the battle. Obviously, we are fighting the devil but so often we forget that or in other words we forget we are fighting the spiritual forces of evil. As we struggle in this life and with people who are opposed to God's Word, we forget that there is a spiritual aspect to all of this. We get caught up trying to deal with them that we forget Paul's words, "we do not wrestle against flesh and blood". Paul is reminding the Ephesians and us that as we fight against the devil and against people who against God and His Word that we not truly fighting them but the forces of evil that are at work behind the scenes. May we never forget that the devil and all his minions are hard at work when dealing with people or institutions that are against God's Word!

So, stand firm against all the assaults of the devil wearing the armor of God. For our God is with you. He is with in the waters of baptism, in the bread and wine, and in His Word. Do not lose heart despite all the world is throwing at you for God is with you! "But take heart; I have overcome the world." May God continue to bless you and give you the strength as you fight against the forces of evil, Amen.




Bus Aid:
