- 1. The Devil always lies. Can you find his lie in Matt 4:9? Where does he get the lie from? (Hint Daniel 7:9-10)
- 2. What does Jesus want?
- 3. Jesus quotes scripture to the Devil, Deuteronomy 6:13 specifically. Does the Devil know scripture better than Jesus? What does that mean for us?

Did God Really Say (Matthew 4:5-7; Luke 4:9-13) Exodus 17:1-7

Gather together at your tables and discuss these verses and ask the question, "Why is it that the devil always desires us to question God's will or his plan?

1. Read Matthew 4:6-7. Is it possible to keep on commandment while breaking another? Is it possible to honor one verse in scripture while disregarding another?
