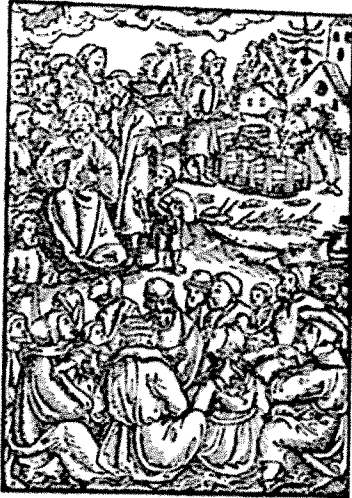
The Lord's Prayer
