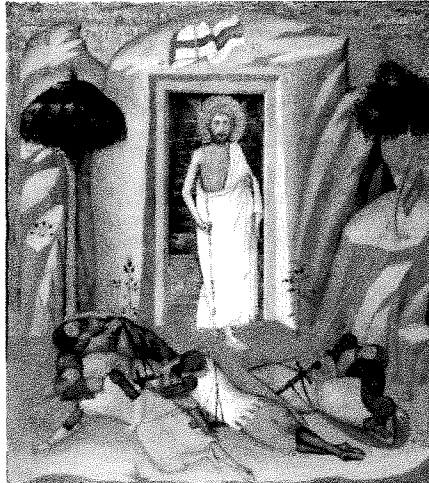

1. What are some major themes in Luke?

Luke 24:1-12

1. What are some similarities to the faith here at the tomb to that of Mary and Martha in the raising of Lazarus?
2. Notice the woman need to have the Gospel explained to them for them to understand.
3. What do the angels tell the woman to remember?
4. Some interesting aspects of Luke 24:6-7
 - a. It is only found in Luke.
 - b. The matter-of-fact tone of the angels compared to that of the women.
 - c. “Remember” is only used 6 times in Luke and each time that which is to be remembered has to do with something God said or did.
 - d. This transports us back to Luke 9.
 - e. The language here is used to refer Jesus’ passion.
 - i. “Son of Man” is used in Luke 9:22, 44; 18:31
 - ii. Dei “It is necessary” or translated in English as “must” in verse 7 links back to 9:22 and used 3 times in Luke 244 (vv. 7, 26, 44).
