- Vs 31: Were there other rabbis who healed?
- When is the man's blindness healed?

Senses As Metaphor:

- Our sense of sight in biblical terms is more often connected with seeing God's truth so is that a combination of seeing with our eyes and our faith or just our faith?
- Can your sight lie to you? (Deep fake)
