- 1. Give your best definition of an apostle? Are there any left?
- 2. How does this align with what we do with the office of Pastor in our church?

#### 3:20-30

- 1. Who is binding up the strong man and what does all this have to do with Beelzebub?
- 2. Why is blaspheming against the Holy Spirit such a big deal for Jesus and now?

- 1. Does it shake you to know that Jesus had "half" brothers?
- 2. Talk a bit about being a brother or sister of Christ?
