3. Do you find it hard to serve the least of these? Is it hard to serve to become great?

10:46-52

1. Why is there a sight miracle here? Does it have anything to do with what came before it?
2. **At Your Tables: Take heart. Get up; he is calling you-**Jesus calls Blind Bartimeus up and away from physical blindness because he can see with eyes of faith. If this phrase was spoken to you, what things do you wish the Lord was calling you out of? Can the Lord still do it? Does it matter how he is present? Perhaps say a prayer for one another that the Lord might call you out...
