  - b. He will not drink of the fruit of the vine until he drinks it “in a new way” (14:25)

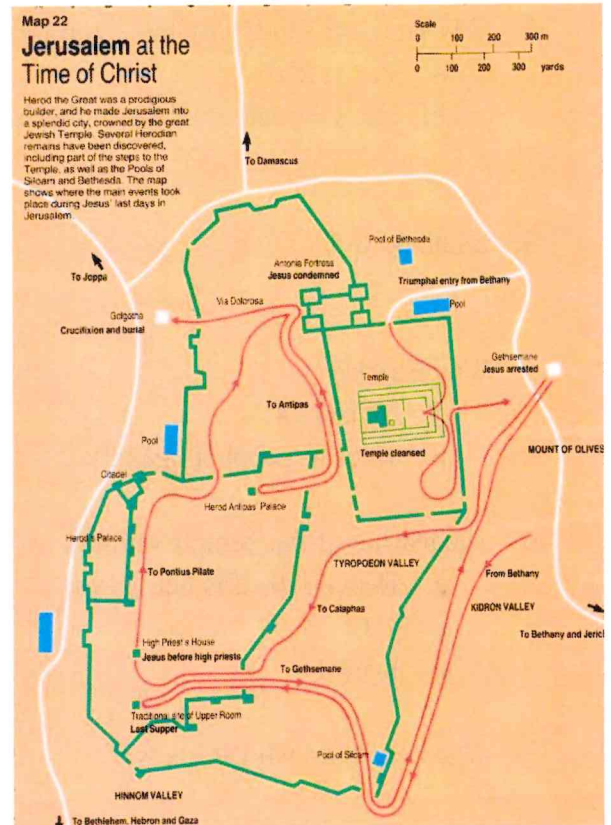
