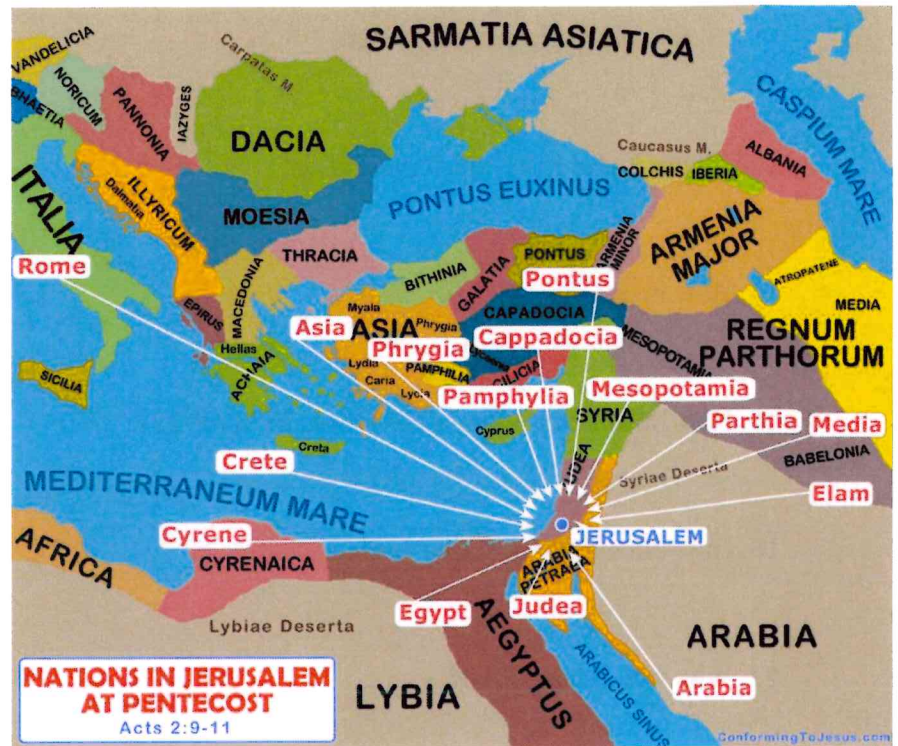


Acts 2
